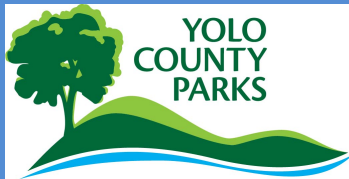

## GENERAL INFO:

**Park Type:** Conservation Area, County Park, Green Space, Regional Park

**Overall Size:** Larger than a football field

**Special Features/Comments:** Just north of the town of Capay, the Capay Open Space Park offers walking trails, picnic benches, and an access ramp to Cache Creek. Explore over 40 acres of enhanced and restored grassland and riparian habitat. Dogs on leash are welcome. Excellent birdwatching area.
